

APA Documentation for Citing Documents from SIRS and EBSCO

**-PLEASE NOTE: All citations should be double-spaced-
ALSO: Second lines, and any consecutive lines of text should be indented five spaces.**

IMPORTANT, if one part of the citation is unavailable, go to the next.
For example: If there is no author, start your citation with the title of the article.

1. Last name of author, initial of first name.
2. Year of publication in parenthesis.
3. Title of article.
4. *Title of publication –italicized,*
5. *Volume number –italicized*
6. Issue number in parenthesis,
7. Page number(s).
8. Retrieved month day, year,
9. from Name of Online Database (SIRS Researcher or EBSCOhost) database.

Examples:
